**Subject: New 7 Wonders of Nature campaign.**

Dear brothers and sisters from Bangladesh,

People from all around the world are now voting online in the final phase for their favourite natural sites, and the sites that will receive the highest votes will be included in the list of '7 wonders of Nature'. The second phase of voting was ended on 07 July 2009 and the Sundarbans remained as a contender for the final phase. Although Cox's Bazar beach was not selected as one of the 28 finalists, it is included in the reserve list and may be selected as a finalist if any of the present finalists is eliminated from the official campaign due to non-observance of the rules of participation or any other reason. Those who have voted in previous phases can now vote again in the final phase.

In view of the above, you are requested to please vote for the Sundarbans as the wonders of Nature. This is how you will vote:

Please go to <http://www.new7wonders.com/>. You will see the steps needed for voting. Please follow the instructions, in the process of which you may need to fill in a registration form which is easy to fill in. You will also require an email address to vote. You can vote once with one email address. **The voting system is open from 21 July 2009** and will remain open throughout 2010 and 2011.

You can't vote on web for the sites in the reserve list. However, you can vote for those sites by international telephone calls. To vote for Cox's Bazar, please follow the instruction below:

1. Dial international telephone number + 41-77-312 4041.
2. At the end of the message, after the tone insert the 4-digit code for your reserve location. Code for Cox's Bazar is 9913.
3. When you hear the thank you message-you are all done.

**You are also requested to please circulate this information among your family members and friends -- in Bangladesh and abroad -- and encourage them to vote for these two sites. Students and the young generation, who are usually good at ICT, are especially requested to take an active part in the campaign, cast their votes, and also help others to vote.**
